The 2016 Amarasco, a varietal Cesanese, opens slowly with a nuanced display of musky black and red currants and savory herbs. This is soft and fleshy in feel, gaining traction through its tart blackberry fruit and hints of sour citrus. A mix of fine tannins and residual acids lingers as this tapers off long yet understated and bitter. Some cellaring may help to unlock further depths, but I'm not convinced.
