Clove, allspice, brown sugar, tobacco and dried black cherries rise up from the glass as the 2015 Amarone della Valpolicella Classico Pergole Vece slowly comes to life. This is velvety and glycerol-like in texture, with ripe red fruits offset by minerals and a twang of bitter dark chocolate, creating a salty-sweet expression. A coating of concentrated raspberry and blackberry lingers, along with hints of sour citrus and framing tannins. The 2015 is just a baby today, and it will benefit from a few years of cellaring. Well done. The Pergole Vece is an old-vine selection which is only produced in what Le Salette deems the best vintages.
