The Terredora di Paolo 2021 Irpinia Coda di Volpe Le Starse should be served very chilled, because that's when the aromas are prettiest. It reveals a light straw color with golden pear, mango and other mild tropical tones. This vintage of Le Starse shows some mild creaminess to its texture. This sets the wine up nicely for a plate of ravioli filled with ricotta and topped with lemon zest. The wine's 14% alcohol content will cut through the cheese and citrus component. Some 13,000 bottles were released.
